DIRECTIONS TO BUTCH WATSON'S SHOP

ADDRESS: BUTCH WATSON, 36 RANDALL ROAD, LEBANON, CT

- **A.** CT RT 2 heading **East** toward Norwich
 - 1. Take exit 22
 - 2. At the end of the ramp turn left
 - 3. Go to the stop sign
 - 4. Cross the road and travel 1.10 miles
 - 5. Turn left on to **Fowler Road---**this is a dirt road
 - 6. Travel 1.10 miles and you will come a stop sign (a church is located on the right)
 - 7. Turn left at the stop sign
 - 8. Butch's place is the second on the left---36 Randall Road
- B. CT RT heading **West** from Norwich
 - 1. Take exit 22
 - 2. At the end of the ramp turn right

Follow steps 3 thru 8 in "A" above

- **C.** From CT RT 16 at the **Colchester Town Green**
 - 1. Take RT 16 East towards Lebanon for approx. 4.2 miles
 - 2. Turn right on to Goshen Hill Road
 - 3. Travel 1.8 miles and turn right on McCall Road
 - 4. Travel 0.4 miles on McCall Road and turn left on to **Church Road** (at sign "GOSHEN HILL CHURCH)
 - 5. Travel 0.8 miles and you will be at the Goshen Hill Church.
 - 6. Just pass the Church there are two dirt roads---one on the left and one almost straight ahead down a small incline. Take the road going down the incline. Butch's place is the second on the left—36 Randall Road
- **D.** From **Hebron Center** at junction of CT Routes 85 and 66
 - 1. Take RT 85 South towards Colchester to CT RT 207 and make a left turn on to CT RT 207.
 - 2. Follow 207 to CT RT 16
 - 3. Turn right onto CT RT 16
 - 4. Travel east on 16 toward Colchester and turn left on to Goshen Hill Road.

Follow steps 3 thru 6 in "C" above

- E. From Lebanon Center
 - 1. Take CT RT 207 South to CT RT 16
 - 2. Turn left on to RT 16
 - 3. Follow Rt 16 to Goshen Hill Road which will be on your left
 - 4. Turn left on Goshen Hill Road.

Follow steps 3 thru 6 in "C" above
