Meeting Demo "Thread Chasing" by Eric Holmquist

Eric explained that hard woods like Blackwood, Cocobolo, Ebony, Pink Ivory, Osage Orange, Lignum Vitae and others are suitable for thread chasing.

When thread chasing for the first time, it is recommended that you start with tools of 16TPI (threads per inch).

Drawing details showing under cuts on external threads and reliefs on internal threads as well as lead in chamfers were not available at the demo.
