

This is "The Pinchot Sycamore" (Platanus Occidentalis)in Simsbury, Ct. what an awesome tree, the trunk is 28 ft. in circumference & the lower branches are massive, it's over 100 ft. tall. It was named for Simsbury native Gifford Pinchot, who served as the first Chief of the United States Forrest Service. It is the largest Sycamore in Ct. It's hard to explain how massive it is. If you are in the Simsbury area its worth stopping by to see.
