### President's Note

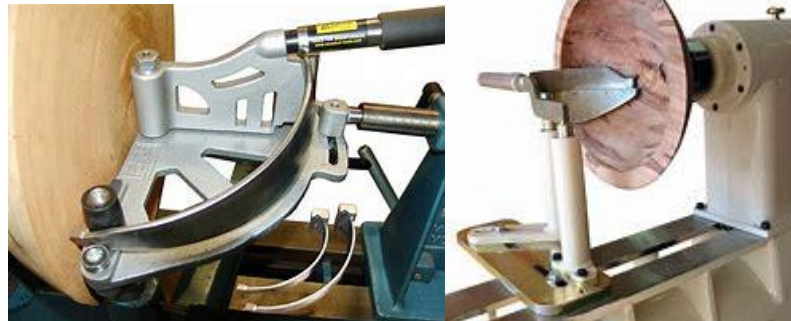
Hello woodturners,

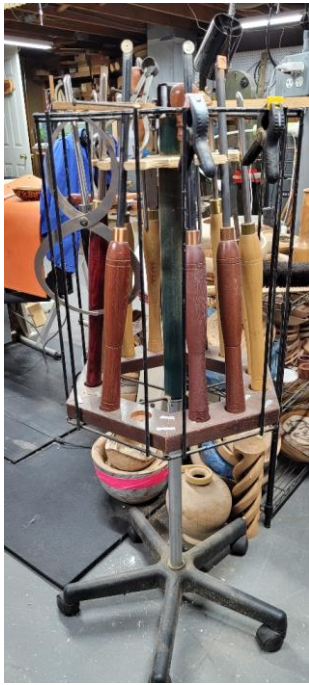
