John made 2 pink pen blanks. He painted inside of pen blank pink so the color of the pen tube wouldn't show through.

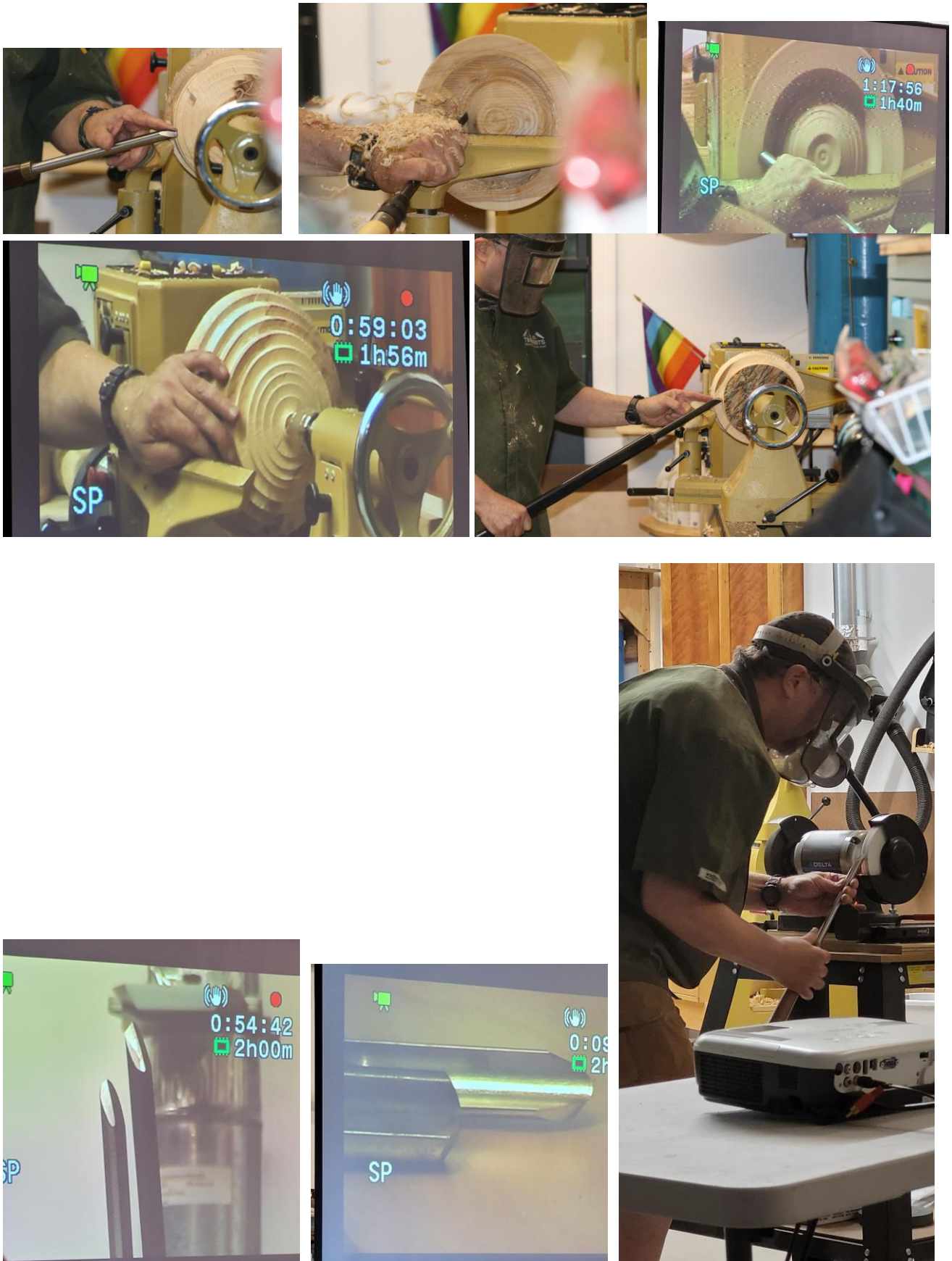
