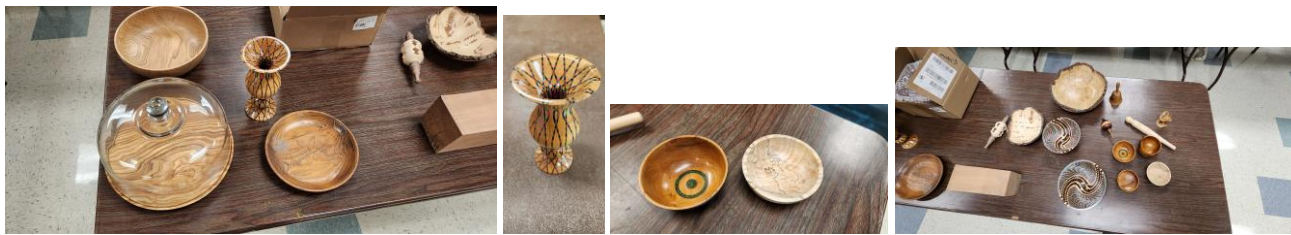
Meeting adjourned 7:06pm
